Don Bosco, a legendary Italian Saint, a luminous educationalist and a great champion of youth, is our founder. With our headquarters in Rome and 132 branches in various countries, we are globally recognized specialists in the field of education for youth. Our system of education is the Preventive System based on the core values of Reason, Religion and Loving Kindness.





WHO IS DON BOSCO

The founder of all these world-wide network of educational institutions of the most varied kinds is Don Bosco, who was born in a little village, Becchi, in Northern Italy in 1815. By hardwork and persevering efforts he became a Priest and decided to dedicate his life for the welfare of youth. In 1859 he founded the Salesian Congregation. MANAGEMENT

The Salesian Community of Don Bosco, Vaduthala holds the total responsibility of running this school. It is managed by Cochin Don Bosco Society and is a Minority Educational Institution covered under Article 30 (1) of the Constitution of India.

STAFF

The members of the staff are well qualified and are given opportunities to develop professionally so that they prove to be an asset to the school. Teachers are responsible for the day-to-day activities within the school as well as for the curricular and overall development of the students.

CURRICULUM

The academic year begins in June and ends in March. The course of study extend from pre-school stage (KG) to Class Twelve (ISC). The pattern of study ranges from an informal type at the pre-school stage to a semi-formal type based on the environmental approach in the early primary school and goes on to a progressively more formal kind in the late Primary, Middle and Secondary.

English is the medium of instruction. Hindi and Malayalam are the additional languages taught. Art, craft, music, physical training, computer skills and indoor/outdoor games are provided to all classes. Summer camps, club activities and workshops are regular features. Social service visits and interventions are also organized. At Don Bosco, we follow the curriculum prescribed by the Council that is flexible, and which engages the pupil's interest.

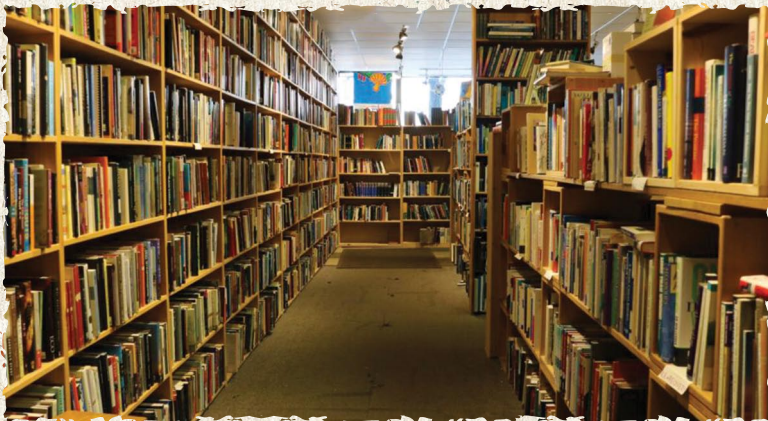
ADMISSION

The school is open to all good and earnest students of all religious faiths. However, Christians are given preference. Admission is

granted only after a written test and an interview (except K.G.) according to the age limit proper to the classes.

LIBRARY

The school library offers the students a tranquil environment to read and enrich themselves. The library offers a wide variety of books ranging from encyclopedia to fiction, magazines and journals. Students can borrow books from the library in the present scenario following Covid- 19 protocols.



PLAYGROUND

PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION (PTA)

The School PTA is intended to be an advisory body to the welfare activities of the school. The function of the PTA is pro-developmental. With regard to the academic and administrative activities of the school, its status is recommendatory. It offers constructive suggestions and works for the welfare of the students and the school.



Examination and Promotion

- 1 The School is affiliated to the CISCE and the students enroll for the ICSE and ISC Examinations.
- 2 All subjects have components of internal assessment on the basis of Assignment, Project, Practical and Course work. Internal marks will be based on two projects/class test (Term I and II), two class tests (Term III) carrying five marks each, general behaviour carrying 5 marks and proficiency in English carrying 5 Marks. These marks are added to the component of the external examination.
- 3 The assessment in “Socially Useful Productive Work and Community Service” will be conducted and the result will count towards the award of certificate.
- 4 Promotion to higher class is based on attendance and consolidated performance of the student during the whole year. His/Her character and conduct is also taken into consideration.
- 5 Promotion will be determined by the cumulative percentage of all the Mid Term and the Terminal Examinations.

- 6 Pupils absenting themselves from examinations without grave reasons will be considered as being failed. Students suffering from contagious or infectious diseases will not be permitted to sit for the offline examination. Pupils absent from any examination for any reason whatsoever, will not be re-examined.
- 7 'No due certificate' is to be obtained in order to collect the hall ticket for the Annual Examination.
- 8 The school reserves the right to remove the students from the roll, if their attendance is irregular or their conduct is harmful to other students.
- 9 Parents will receive the result through SMS. Once the result is published, parents are expected to check the report card through ecMS.

School Fees

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- 1 The reduced fee structure of 2020-21 shall continue to be followed during the time of online classes of the academic year 2021-22.
- 2 The school fee for the year is divided into four terms/ instalments.
- 3 Monthly payment of fee can be arranged upon a written request by the parent/guardian.
- 4 It is the duty of the parents to pay the fees on or before the due date mentioned in the Fee Card.
- 5 The school fee can be remitted online or offline in any branch of the Federal Bank in the prescribed challan on or before the due dates. The school copy of the challan/ online payment receipt is to be submitted in the school office.
- 6 Online payment will be considered as fees paid only after the amount credited into school account. In case of noncredit due to technical issues, submit the proof of payment in school office without further delay.



GENERAL RULES

PARENTS

1. Create a positive environment for learning: ensure your child has suitable gadgets, good internet connection, learning materials like textbooks, notebooks, etc.
2. Encourage the child to manage their time in an effective way.
3. Should check the daily timetable & make sure their child attend classes on time.
4. Ensure students attend Webex sessions on time and stay connected throughout.
5. Ensure that the child completes homework/assignment & upload through ecMS on time.
6. There shall be ZERO parental intervention during Webex sessions for all classes except KG and LP sections.
7. Double check the quality of uploads: clarity and readability.
8. Contact class teacher if there is any ecMS technical issue.
9. Enquire about the child's performance by sending messages through Whatsapp or periodic call with the subject teacher.
10. Should monitor child's phone usage (online games, videos, etc. should be proportionate).
11. Parents must check the messages from the school/teachers via ecMS.

12. Parents are expected to remit the school fee before the due date which makes students eligible for online classes.
13. Inform class teacher or subject teacher in advance if their ward would be absent for the webinar.

STUDENTS

1. Follow a systematic timetable for the entire day.
2. Attendance in the webex sessions is mandatory.
3. Check frequently the messages and class links sent by the teachers through ecMS.
4. Make sure you are in a room suitable for attending the class and Webex meeting without any disturbances and background noises.
5. Be punctual and well-groomed for the classes, especially while attending the Webex meeting.
6. Be ready with the required gadgets and study materials for the classes and Webex meeting.
7. Ensure phone/laptop, etc. is fully charged and strong internet connection before classes begin.
8. It is mandatory to watch the online class before attending respective Webex meeting.
9. Be ready with the subject books/ note books during the online class and Webex meeting.
10. Be an active participant in Webex session and effectively make use of the facility to clarify your doubts.
11. Always be on mute during Webex sessions, unless instructed by the teacher.
12. Switch to video mode as per the instruction of the teacher.
13. Complete Homework and Assignment on time; every upload should have Name, Class-Division, Roll no, etc.
14. Assignment/ Homework may not always be descriptive questions. Instead, they may simply point to certain question

numbers on certain page numbers of textbook. In such cases, students are expected to refer textbooks.

15. Write in a neat handwriting. Only good quality images should be uploaded to ecMS .
16. Acknowledge the messages sent by teachers through broadcast.
17. Absentees should contact the subject teacher as well as the class teacher without fail and with proper reasons.
18. Be sincere and take up the responsibility of your studies.
19. Attend without fail all periodic tests and assessments conducted by teachers to check your progress.
20. Avoid unnecessary use of gadgets and indulge in productive activities in your leisure time.
21. Take initiative in informing your parents on your progress in learning and make the best of the online facility and the quality time with your family.
22. As required by the online classes, students would be spending time watching electronic screens like mobile, computer, etc., they are advised to minimize their screen time for healthy eyes and brains.
23. Actively participate in all activities conducted by the School.
24. Obligatory for every student of our school to be part of 'Fit India Movement' initiated by Central Government. PT teachers will provide guidelines on this matter.
